That the PETITIONER applies to and desires to secure from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission the authority to: (Please CIRCLE the class you are applying for)

- A1. Holders of these permits may enter any phase of the anhydrous ammonia business.
- A2. Holders of these permits may install and service anhydrous ammonia containers, piping and appliances, but shall not deliver anhydrous ammonia.
- A3. Holders of these permits may engage in the filling of approved cylinders with anhydrous on their premises, but shall not deliver anhydrous ammonia.
- A3-X. Holders of these permits may engage in the exchange of approved anhydrous ammonia highways of the state of Louisiana, but shall not sell product in the state.
- A4. Holders of these permits may transport anhydrous ammonia by motor vehicle over the highways of the state of Louisiana, but shall not sell product in the state.
- A4-E. Holders of these permits may transport anhydrous ammonia over the highways of the state of Louisiana but shall not sell product in the state. These permits are valid for 90 days from the date of issuance and may be secured from the office of the Director.

PETITIONER states herewith:

- A. That he has had the necessary experience, or agrees to employ a qualified person who is competent:
 - 1. In the handling of anhydrous ammonia.
 - 2. In the installation and operation of the equipment he proposes to sell.
- B. That he has secured, or will secure, the equipment necessary for the proper operations of a dealer in the particular phase of the industry for which he is applying for a permit to operate, and that said equipment will comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission at present in force, and any amendments thereto.
- C. That he carries, or will secure, all forms of insurance as required in the Rules and Regulations of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission.
- D. That he will be willing to furnish the Commission with a financial statement.
- E. That he has a thorough knowledge of R. S. 3:1351 through 1357 and of the Rules and Regulations of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission.

If and when the authority herein applied for shall be granted, PETITIONER agrees to comply with all provisions of the Law and Rules and Regulations of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission at present in force or that may be hereafter issued, relating to the anhydrous ammonia industry.

Also, attached hereto, is a filing fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for Class A1; twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for Classes A2, A3, A4, A4-E; and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for Class A3-X, made payable to the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission; and the first year's permit fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for all classes except A4-E the permit fee is three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325.00), as prescribed by Law.

Must have on file in the office of the Director proof of insurance or financial security on an LPG proprietary insurance certificate form (downloadable off our website) in the minimum sum of \$1,000,000.00. This may be done with a certificate of insurance, a binder for insurance, posting of bonds or other securities or certificates of deposits on similar instruments. This shall not be construed as reducing the insurance requirements imposed by laws or rules and regulations of the federal government or the State of Louisiana. The following classes of insurance will be required in the minimum sum of \$1,000,000.00 for each class permit designated.
