LAC 55:IX.(1)(F).§167, requires that a leak check or test shall be performed in all out-of-gas, interruption—of--service or first-time-servi ce to a new customer. The purpose of this leak check or test is to determine whether your gas system has a leak which could cause a fire or explosion. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission, your container service valve has been shut off and placed out-of-service.

You must contact a liquefied petroleum dealer or other qualified agency to perform a leak check or test on your gas system. If you choose to place the gas system back into service without the required leak check or test you will assume the risk of the gas system.

The law further states that any end user who authorizes the maintenance and/or repair, installation, adjustment, and/or service of a liquefied petroleum gas system shall insure that any person, firm, or corporation authorized to perform such services shall have a proper and current permit or registration and current card of competency from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission. The end user authorizing such actions shall notify the liquefied petroleum gas dealer, who normally services the gas system, within 5 working days of receiving this notice or before the system is next serviced with gas, which ever comes first. The notification must include the name of the person, firm or corporation performing the actions and what actions were taken.
