Any L. P. Gas or Anhydrous Ammonia installation or system found <u>"NOT"</u> in compliance with the Revised Statutes or the Commission's Rules and Regulations will be <u>"CONDEMNED"</u> for further use until compliance is achieved. This will be accomplished by posting a <u>"CONDEMNED"</u> INSTALLATION" decal on the installation or system or by publishing it in the monthly AD letter.

The L. P. Gas Commission requires proof of insurance <u>on a Commission proprietary certificate of insurance form as of November 1, 2005</u>. This proprietary certificate of insurance will be provided via facsimile or via mail upon request or can be downloaded from our website at <u>www.dps.louisiana.gov/lpg</u>. Insurance requirements are \$1,000,000 in each class of insurance required by Commission rules.

SEVERAL NEW RULES AND SOME AMENDED RULES ARE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007. Please refer to our web site for these new rules and amended rules.

AS A REMINDER TO ALL NEW APPLICANTS AND SUPPLIERS, Application requests shall be ADMINSTRATIVELY GRANTED by the office of the Director upon completion of ALL Commission requirements as set forth in the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 55, and the

Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended. Requirements vary by permit class but include submission of a formal application, permit fee, filing fee, certificate of insurance on approved proprietary form, and may include employee certification, sketch of installations, and/or inspections of transport vehicles. Under the authority of the Director, the applicant may engage in the specified L.P. Gas business immediately as a licensed permit holder with the Commission. The application process is finalized by the Commission ratifying the permit at their first subsequent meeting after the applicant has completed all necessary requirements.
