### JULY 2006 CONDEMNED/UNCONDEMNED SYSTEMS

Amerigas Propane LP representative, Mary Helen Patterson, permanently **condemned** the following LP Gas Tank: 1. 250 gallon, Beaird Tank, located at 350 Gill Rd, Boyce, LA. Serial # JG34106. Hole in bottom of tank was causing it to leak gas. Authorities contacted, emergency personnel responded, and incident resolved without fire, injuries, and only 10 gallons of gas lost.
