## TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The Commission has <u>temporarily suspended</u>, September 1, 2005, through October 31, 2005, administrative rules in non-safety areas, such as timely renewal of permit and card fees, proof of insurance requirements (this does not mean without insurance, only that the <u>proof of insurance</u> to the Commission is suspended), truck registration requirements, installation report requirements, monthly purchases and sales report requirements, sketch requirements, new permit requirements and others as may be appropriate. In all areas where the rules are temporarily suspended, the requirements will still have to be met but at a later date. <u>ALL RULES THAT ARE DIRECTLY RELATED TO SAFETY ARE STILL IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AND WILL BE ENFORCED</u>. In order to qualify for the temporary suspension of any of the rules the violator would have to be <u>directly</u> impacted by Hurricane Katrina and/or the aftermath thereof. Other circumstances which are <u>related to Hurricane Katrina</u> will be considered for temporary suspension as well. By all means be safe and be sure to completely check all installations that had wind or water damage whether required by rule or not. <u>THE ABOVE WILL ALSO APPLY TO HURRICANE RITA</u>.
