2001 Registration Truck Tag Renewals have been mailed out. Please read "ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY" before processing. After April 30, all truck renewals, new registrations as well as the inspection must be performed through a Commission Inspector. ALSO, AFTER APRIL 30, NO INSPECTIONS, RENEWALS OR NEW REGISTRATIONS WILL BE HANDLED BY MAIL. Upon receipt of the transmittal with the tag attached the inspection must be performed within 90 days of the "Inspection Due By" date or by August 1, 2000 whichever comes first. The 2001 School Bus/Mass Transit Registrations have been mailed. These registrations require "NO FEES", but must be returned to the L. P. Gas Commission for issuance of a decal to be attached to the unit by April 30, 2001. Units not registered by April 30, 2001 <u>may not be fueled</u> with L. P. Gas.
