3. The subject equipment must be currently registered with the LA L.P. Gas Comm.
4. The company requesting the reciprocal safety inspection(s) must be a current permit holder in Louisiana.
5. The request(s) is/are for transport inspection(s) only.
6. The following must be given for each reciprocal safety inspection requested.
